They seek closeness with their fellow students because it motivates them. The presence of other people who also want to learn makes them productive. The atmosphere, community spirit, and visual stimuli of people learning can have a motivational effect. We believe that the ideal solution to this problem is to conduct online lessons on the Zoom platform. As you know, this is an excellent service for distance learning in quarantine. Anyone can set up a meeting by creating an account.

RESULTS

A free account allows you to conduct video classes up to 40 minutes long. The program is great for individual and group lessons, students can log in both from a computer and from a tablet with a phone. Anyone with a link or conference ID can join the video conference. The event can be scheduled in advance, and you can also make a recurring link, that is, for a regular class at a certain time, you can make the same entry link.

Many students find it difficult to study at home. They allow themselves to be distracted, waste time, and manage only a fraction of what would be possible. The reason for this is often a lack of or inconsistent motivation. But in most cases, small adjustments in workflows are enough to significantly increase motivation when studying at home. Learning with digital materials will help students expand their creativity.
