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## Formation of Creative Skills in Primary Class Students through Folk Songs

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**Abstract:** This article provides information about the technologies of formation of creative abilities of elementary school students by means of folk songs and their role in the child's development.

In order to find a practical solution to social and educational problems in the world, the need to introduce modern educational standards into the primary education system and clarify the development strategy of primary education has become stronger. Relying on international experiences, improving the primary education system based on innovative approaches, in the concept of international education until 2030 adopted by UNESCO, "Creating the opportunity to receive quality education throughout life" is considered as the main task, and primary education Systematic works are being carried out on the formation of its content based on these relations. In developed countries, it is important to carry out scientific research on the formation of the educational process focused on the interests, abilities, requirements, needs, and opportunities of each student.

It has been shown that the most important factor in developing the musical ability of the young generation worldwide is the formation of their interest in music and the orientation of music to emotional acceptance. In this regard, it explains the necessity of forming creative abilities in elementary school students through folk songs in order to develop their content, methods and tools in the process of primary education.

In our republic, it is important to improve the quality of education based on mastering musical knowledge of primary school students based on folk songs. After all, as the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan Sh. Mirziyoyev stated, it is necessary to "... give a number of privileges to primary educational institutions". In this, an individual approach to each elementary school student based on his psychological and physical development characteristics, requirements and needs, improvement of the content and forms of the work carried out with them, scientific, didactic and it is important to study the technological aspects.

Uzbek musicologists such as G.Zafari, A.Fitrat, Yu.Rajabi, I.Rajabov, F.Karamatov, M.Yusupov, T.Gafurbekov, A.Matyokubov, R.Abdullaev, O.Ibrohimov, J.Rasultoyev who deeply analyzed the melodious aspects of folk songs, put them into notes, developed theoretical and practical aspects of their perception.

Psychologists - I.Leontev, V.Krutetsky, E.Nazaykinsky, N.Kuzmina, M.Davletshin, K.Kalibekova and others in their research have deeply analyzed the characteristics of young psychology of students and their activities of musical perception.
