- widely promote the goals and objectives of Uzbekistan in building a peaceful policy of our country, a democratic rule of law and a strong civil society in foreign countries, as well as the successes achieved today in all spheres of the country's life;
- Assistance and direct participation in the organization of research and development work aimed at further development and harmonization of international relations and friendly relations with foreign countries. [2]

Much attention is paid to international relations in the modernizing Uzbekistan. Cooperation with many countries of the world in all areas, studying their experience and applying it in practice is one of the priorities of our country.
